DASGS UNIFORM REGULATIONS

The intention of the Dress Code is to promote commitment to excellence and appropriate behaviour through smart and sober outward appearance which reflects well on the student, their parents, guardians, families, sponsors and the College. Students are expected to be neatly dressed at all times while on the College campus.

At the Division of Arts, Sciences and General Studies, Students are permitted to wear either the green college uniform or white college polo shirt with blue or black jeans. Please note that the college polo is not to be worn with the green skirt (females) or pants.

GUIDLINES FOR FEMALES

Female Students (The following rules must be adhered to whenever the student is in the college uniform, whether during or after school hours.)

Uniform - Students must wear:

- 1. A loosely fitting white cotton blouse/shirt (buttons down the front) with at least 6 inch sleeves over tailored, bottle green pants.
- 2. Pants must not be tight fitting.
- 3. Skirt no more than two inches above the knee and made from the same fabric as the trousers.
- 4. Skirts must not be too tight.
- 5. Waistcoat should be hip length.
- 6. Only Black or brown enclosed shoes (Sneakers or flats).
- 7. Modest jewellery
- 8. NO large brightly coloured earnings or bangles.

Hair and Face:

- 1. Headgear is **NOT** allowed while in uniform, unless permission is given for religious purposes
- 2. Hairstyles must be neat and clean.
- 3. NO hats are allowed with uniform.
- 4. NO gaudy head scarves and bright hair decorations are allowed
- 5. NO brightly coloured hair dye, braids or weave. Dye, braids or weaves must be of natural hair colours.
- 6. NO brightly coloured weaves. Weave colour must match the student's natural hair colour.
- 7. NO brightly coloured braids. Braid colour must match the student's natural hair colour and must be no longer than waist length.
- 8. Face powder is allowed but brightly coloured eye shadow and lipstick and lash extensions are not allowed.

9. Conventional jewelry may be worn – gold, silver or costume. If costume jewelry is worn, colors must be restricted to gold, silver, transparent, white, black or green. No more than one pair of earring (one in each ear) is allowed.

GUIDLINES FOR MALES

Male Students (The following rules must be adhered to whenever the student is in the college uniform, whether during or after school hours.)

Uniform - Students must wear:

- 1. A loosely fitting white cotton shirt with at least 6 inch sleeves neatly tucked into tailored, bottle green trousers. Any other green colour trousers are **NOT** permitted.
- 2. Trousers that are loose fitting and without outside pockets.
- 3. Only black or brown enclosed shoes. NB: Shoe should be a solid black or brown shoe with the corresponding colour shoe lace.

Hair and Face

- 1. Headgear is **NOT** allowed while in uniform, unless permission is given by the dean or deputy dean.
- 2. Hairstyles must be neat and clean. Only natural hair colours are permitted.
- 3. NO hats are allowed while on the college compound.
- 4. Earrings are **NOT** permitted while in school uniform.

FURTHER GUIDLINES

- > Students are required to wear the uniform approved by the College for regular class sessions and occasions specified by the College.
- > Jeans pants worn should NOT be damaged or distressed and should be full lenght. Shorts and capris are not allowed.
- > Students are not permitted to wear slippers, Crocs, or sandals unless accompanied by a medical excuse.
- ➤ In cases where permission is granted for departure from the prescribed dress code (example pay and wear), students must dress modestly. Tights, shorts, short skirts, sleeveless or tank tops are not permitted on the campus.

REMINDER

These are not allowed.

- · Crocs, slippers, sandals, flip-flops
- White or black and white shoes or other coloured foot ware.
- · Caps, hats and other head gear.
- Excessive Jewellery and make-up
- Earrings for males
- Nose rings, tongues rings etc.
- Polo shirt with green skirt or pants
- · Distressed jeans, short or Capri jeans pants
- · Tight and or Skirts more than two inches above the knee
- Coloured hair, weave or braids (allowed colours are shades of black and brown)

The College administration reserves the right to debar from classes or any other activity, students who do not comply with the prescribed dress code
